## General Assembly

The SIM General Assembly (GA) was held from 27 to 28 September, 2018.

During the GA the status of the SIM legal entity was updated, the incorporation of 6 new NMIs was approved, being now 26 NMIs the members of SIM legal entity. Modification of SIM statutes and membership fees were discussed and the status of all SIM projects was reviewed.

A new SIM president was elected: Dr. Claire Saundry, from the National Institute for Standards and Technology (NIST).

During the week of the GA other activities took place: the QSTF held its semesterly meeting and two workshops in mass metrology and the new ISO17025 took place.

#### IAAC

### **General Assembly**

The IAAC General Assembly took place in Montego Bay, Jamaica, during the third week of August 2018. 80 representatives from accreditation bodies of 22 countries participated in technical meetings to develop policies and make strategic decisions which have an impact on the national accreditation systems in the region. The IAAC members elected a new IAAC Chair and Vice-Chair, as well as other key positions. The IAAC MLA Group reviewed the evaluation reports of several members to confirm their compliance with international standards as well as IAF and ILAC requirements. IAAC reviewed the results of its intensive program of training activities focusing on different technical topics as decided by its subcommittees. The R3E cooperation project included activities related to peer evaluator training which is necessary to maintain the technical competence of the region's experts. The next IAAC meetings will be held in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil, from March 18-21, 2019.
